

Saw a small recent looking storm slab avalanche that appeared to be naturally triggered above the road on a south facing slope around 6000'. It ran all the way across the slope  $\sim$ 30' wide and  $\sim$ 4" deep within the recent snow. The snow didn't move far enough to reach the road. The slope was quite steep-- we didn't measure but I'd estimate 40\*.
